Essential | sessionid | Maintains user session | Session only

Analytics | _ga, _gid | Google Analytics – usage statistics | 1 day – 2 years

Functionality | preferences | Saves visitor display options | 6 months

Third-party | yt-player, maps | Enables YouTube or Google Maps | Varies by provider
